Eyes Forward After Breakout



Technical Highlights

After bottoming at a 52-week low of RM1.42, the stock has staged a sharp reversal, rallying 61% over just 34 days. Since then, it entered an accumulation phase, forming a visible triangle pattern. Yesterday's breakout from this consolidation range, backed by strong volume—the highest since May 2025, signalled a shift in sentiment. With the price now comfortably above both the 20-day and 50-day EMAs, this breakout looks technically sound. A healthy pullback in the coming sessions would be ideal to confirm the breakout and set the stage for a new leg higher.

Momentum indicators are flashing green. The RSI has risen to 61, recovering from several weeks stuck around the neutral 50 level. More notably, the MACD has formed a bullish golden cross and is now pointing upward, reinforcing the positive bias.

An ideal entry sits around RM2.30, with the next target at RM2.55 if momentum sustains. On the downside, a break below RM1.89 would invalidate the current setup and suggest a failed breakout, likely inviting further selling.

Oversold No More



Technical Highlights

After trending downward since May 2025 and hitting a fresh 52-week low in July, the stock has finally broken out of its downtrend line just yesterday, backed by convincing volume. July also marked a significant accumulation phase, as price volatility narrowed and buyers gradually absorbed selling pressure. This pattern of accumulation signals a shift in sentiment, with early signs of bullish intent now confirmed by a breakout and renewed interest from market participants.

Momentum indicators are looking good. The RSI, which was deeply oversold in June, has since rebounded to 41. At the same time, the MACD has just formed a golden cross last week and is still trending upward.

An ideal entry lies between RM1.11 and RM1.14. Should the momentum sustain, the next key resistance levels to watch are RM1.21 and RM1.28. However, if the stock slips below RM1.05, it would signal a breakdown below the 52-week low, likely triggering another round of selling.

Glossary of commonly used technical terms

Exponential Moving Average (EMA)	An indicator frequently used in technical analysis showing the average value of a security's price over a set period with greater weightage placed on the most recent data points.
Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD)	A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices. The MACD is calculated by subtracting the 26-day exponential moving average (EMA) from the 12-day EMA. A 9-day EMA of the MACD, called the "signal line", is then plotted on top of the MACD, functioning as a trigger for buy and sell signals.
Stochastic	A technical momentum indicator that compares a security's closing price to its price range over a given time period. The indicator's sensitivity to market movements can be reduced by adjusting the time period or by taking a moving average of the result.
Average True Range (ATR)	A measure of volatility whereby the indicator is the greatest of the following: - current high less the current low; - the absolute value of the current high less the previous close; - the absolute value of the current low less the previous close;
Bollinger Band	A band plotted 2 standard deviations away from a simple moving average.
On-Balance Volume (OBV)	A method used in technical analysis to detect momentum, the calculation of which relates volume to price change. OBV provides a running total of volume and shows whether this volume is flowing in or out of a given security.
Support	The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.
Resistance	The price at which a stock or market can trade, but not exceed, for a certain period of time. Often referred to as "resistance level".
Reversal	A change in the direction of a price trend. On a price chart, reversals undergo a recognizable change in the price structure. An uptrend, which is a series of higher highs and higher lows, reverses into a downtrend by changing to a series of lower highs and lower lows. A downtrend, which is a series of lower highs and lower lows, reverses into an uptrend by changing to a series of higher highs and higher lows.
Divergence	When the price of an asset and an indicator, index or other related asset move in opposite directions.
Overbought	In technical analysis, this term describes a situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.
Oversold	A situation in technical analysis where the price of an asset has fallen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that the oscillator has reached a lower bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors
