Above the Clouds Now



Technical Highlights

After reaching its 52-week low in March, the stock has begun carving out a reversal pattern. It pulled back healthily near the 200-day EMA, consolidating into a classic bull flag formation. Just last Friday, it finally broke out of this flag with conviction, marking the strongest buying volume since May 2025. With the price now trading above both the 20- and 50-day EMAs, this breakout hints at a shift in trend. If the stock can sustain above the breakout point and retest it successfully, it opens up room for further upside. However, the immediate resistance to watch is the 200-day EMA, which stands as the first real test of strength.

Momentum indicators are lining up well. The RSI has steadily climbed to 60 after staying range-bound for months. At the same time, the MACD has also formed a golden cross last Friday.

An ideal entry zone sits between RM0.670–RM0.690. If momentum follows through, the next resistance levels are at RM0.730 and RM0.770 respectively. But if the stock dips below RM0.640, it would invalidate the breakout and signal potential downside continuation.

Technical Highlights

After hitting its 52-week high back in October 2024, the stock has been sliding in a persistent downtrend. Just last week, it attempted to break above this trendline, but the push wasn't strong enough, and shows a pulled back. However, things turned interesting last Friday, where it closed with a hammer candlestick, often a sign of reversal, alongside a move above both the 20- and 50-day EMAs. What makes it more compelling is the surge in buying volume, the highest recorded since November 2024.

Momentum-wise, the indicators are looking good. The RSI has edged up to 61. Meanwhile, the MACD has also just formed a golden cross last week.

The ideal entry range sits at RM0.280 to RM0.290. The first resistance to watch is RM0.300, followed by RM0.325 if momentum continues to build. That said, if the stock breaks below RM0.265, this would invalidate the bullish setup and suggest the downtrend still has legs—especially if it drops below the previous low.

Glossary of commonly used technical terms

Exponential Moving Average (EMA)

An indicator frequently used in technical analysis showing the average value of a security's price over a set period with greater weightage placed on the most recent data points.

Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD)

A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices. The MACD is calculated by subtracting the 26-day exponential moving average (EMA) from the 12-day EMA. A 9-day EMA of the MACD, called the "signal line", is then plotted on top of the MACD, functioning as a trigger for buy and sell signals.

Stochastic

A technical momentum indicator that compares a security's closing price to its price range over a given time period. The indicator's sensitivity to market movements can be reduced by adjusting the time period or by taking a moving average of the result.

Average True Range (ATR)

A measure of volatility whereby the indicator is the greatest of the following:

- current high less the current low;
- the absolute value of the current high less the previous close;
- the absolute value of the current low less the previous close;

Bollinger Band

A band plotted 2 standard deviations away from a simple moving average.

On-Balance Volume (OBV)

A method used in technical analysis to detect momentum, the calculation of which relates volume to price change. OBV provides a running total of volume and shows whether this volume is flowing in or out of a given security.

The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.

Resistance

The price at which a stock or market can trade, but not exceed, for a certain period of time. Often

referred to as "resistance level".

Reversal

Support

A change in the direction of a price trend. On a price chart, reversals undergo a recognizable change in the price structure. An uptrend, which is a series of higher highs and higher lows, reverses into a downtrend by changing to a series of lower highs and lower lows. A downtrend, which is a series of lower highs and lower lows, reverses into an uptrend by changing to a series of higher highs and higher lows.

Divergence

When the price of an asset and an indicator, index or other related asset move in opposite directions.

Overbought

In technical analysis, this term describes a situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.

Oversold

A situation in technical analysis where the price of an asset has fallen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that the oscillator has reached a lower bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors



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
