The stock last closed at RM0.455, continuing its upward momentum after breaking above Support 1 at RM0.420. The stock is now approaching the immediate resistance at RM0.475, with strong buying momentum supporting the bullish trend.

The RSI stands at 72.39, indicating strong buying interest but an overbought condition. MACD remains positive and above the signal line, supporting the bullish momentum. The stock remains above the 20-day EMA at RM0.406, 50-day EMA at RM0.391 and 200-day EMA at RM0.406, maintaining its bullish trend.

On the upside, the immediate target is RM0.475, with further strength potentially extending towards RM0.500 should momentum build. Conversely, a breach below its support levels would invalidate the bullish outlook and expose the stock to further downside.

### Technical Highlights

The stock last closed at RM1.950, breaking above the ascending parallel channel formed since late June 2026, signalling strong bullish momentum. The breakout suggests further upside towards the immediate resistance at RM2.005.

The RSI stands at 76.21, indicating strong buying interest but an overbought condition. MACD remains positive and above the signal line, supporting the bullish momentum. The stock remains above the 20-day EMA at RM1.523, 50-day EMA at RM1.374 and 200-day EMA at RM1.223, maintaining its bullish trend.

On the upside, the immediate target is RM 2.005, with further strength potentially extending towards RM2.315 should momentum build. Conversely, a breach below its support levels would invalidate the bullish outlook and expose the stock to further downside.

| Exponential Moving Average (EMA)             | An indicator frequently used in technical analysis showing the average value of a security's price over a set period with greater weightage placed on the most recent data points.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                            |
| Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD) | A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices. The MACD is calculated by subtracting the 26-day exponential moving average (EMA) from the 12-day EMA. A 9-day EMA of the MACD, called the "signal line", is then plotted on top of the MACD, functioning as a trigger for buy and sell signals.                                                                      |
| Stochastic                                   | A technical momentum indicator that compares a security's closing price to its price range over a given time period. The indicator's sensitivity to market movements can be reduced by adjusting the time period or by taking a moving average of the result.                                                                                                                                                                 |
| Average True Range (ATR)                     | A measure of volatility whereby the indicator is the greatest of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- current high less the current low;</li> <li>- the absolute value of the current high less the previous close;</li> <li>- the absolute value of the current low less the previous close;</li> </ul>                                                                                                   |

| On-Balance Volume (OBV)                      | A method used in technical analysis to detect momentum, the calculation of which relates volume to price change. OBV provides a running total of volume and shows whether this volume is flowing in or out of a given security.                                                                                                                                                                                               |
| Support                                      | The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                |
| Resistance                                   | The price at which a stock or market can trade, but not exceed, for a certain period of time. | Reversal                                     | A change in the direction of a price trend. On a price chart, reversals undergo a recognizable change in the price structure. An uptrend, which is a series of higher highs and higher lows, reverses into a downtrend by changing to a series of lower highs and lower lows. A downtrend, which is a series of lower highs and lower lows, reverses into an uptrend by changing to a series of higher highs and higher lows. |

| Overbought                                   | In technical analysis, this term describes a situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.                                                                                                       |
| Oversold                                     | A situation in technical analysis where the price of an asset has fallen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that the oscillator has reached a lower bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors                                                                                                          |

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
